DOOR COUNTY MASTER GARDENERS

Master Gardeners will be on the WDOR talk show the third Thursday of each month from 10:20 to 11:00 am. WDOR can be heard on 93.9 FM and 910 AM. Each program will feature a “What’s New in the Master Gardener Organization” section, an educational topic and a featured garden area in the Garden Door. The show is a call in show, so listeners can call in with their comments/questions as well. Carrie Sherrill will provide the “What’s New” information and coordinate guest speakers from within the Door County Master Gardener organization for various seasonal topics and Garden Door area discussions.

How to become a Master Gardener will be explained monthly to the listening audience.

The following topics and speakers are scheduled:

- March 15, 2018: Educational programs at Crossroads, educational topic, spring bulbs (bulbs in general), planting, dividing, storing for winter. Possibly Vicki Dirst or Jeanne Vogel. We will feature a Garden Door area with Bulbs. Mention the greenhouse and what is happening there.
- April 19, 2018: Upcoming educational programs at Crossroads, Carl Scholz for Earth Day and environmental topics, Native Plants with either Karen Newbern or Chriss Daubner, and the Butterfly Garden at the Garden Door (Chriss Daubner). Also mention that we are accepting donated plants for the plant sale. Giving contact info regarding this. Update on the greenhouse.
- May 17, 2018: The Plant Sale with Karen Kidd, dividing perennials possibly featuring Lucy Kile, featured garden: Perennial Garden at the Garden Door (possibly Nancy Anschutz). Talk briefly about Tuesdays in the Garden Door.
- June 21, 2018: Talk about the upcoming Open House and the ongoing Tuesdays in the Garden Door. Provide a list of area gardens to visit: The Garden Door, Community Gardens in Algoma and Sturgeon Bay, West of the Lake Garden in Manitowoc, The Green Bay Botanical Garden, The Rotary Garden in Janesville, Olbrich Gardens in Madison. Raised bed gardening with John Werblow. The featured Garden Door area is the Raised Beds with Barb Henkleman or Dorry Wilner.
- July 19, 2018: Tuesdays in the Garden Door, Plant Health advisors with Annie Deutsch, Invasives in Door County with either Karen Newbern, Coggin Heeringa or Gary Kemp. Cactus garden is the featured garden, hopefully with Jim Freidrichs.
- August 16, 2018: Tuesdays in the Garden Door, Harvesting your crops. Freezing/Canning tips from someone at UW-Extension. Pond and Pond Garden is featured Garden Door Area with Steve Kryzsanowski or Cliff White.
- September 20, 2018: What’s happening with the Master Gardeners, Succulents in the garden, shade plants. Featured garden area either Shade Garden or Succulent/Spiral area. Possible speakers Barb Henderson, Kaylynn Litersky or Shawn Mathys.
- October 18, 2018: Fall Symposium info. Fall garden clean-up and planting fall bulbs, possible speakers Wendy Woldt or Susan Morgan. Training class info with Michelle and Gary Kemp. Garden Door area Tunnel/Meditation Garden or Fairie Garden.
